

Clinical Laboratory Faculty Members in Genomics: New York City

The Department of Pathology and Cell Biology at Columbia University is recruiting for two additional full-time faculty members for the Cytogenetics Laboratory and the Laboratory of Personalized Genomic Medicine at the Columbia University Medical Center-New York Presbyterian Hospital. These are full-service clinical laboratories in the Division of Laboratory Medicine with responsibility for performing all prenatal, postnatal, and cancer cytogenetic, molecular diagnostic, and genomic clinical laboratory testing for a large academic medical center. The successful candidates for these two positions will have M.D., Ph.D., or M.D./Ph.D. degrees, can be appointed at any relevant rank (i.e., Assistant, Associate, or Full Professor), have relevant board certification, and are eligible for the relevant New York State Certificates of Qualification. They will be expected to be part of a highly interactive team in clinical and laboratory genetics and to pursue their interests in clinical and/or translational research. The presence on our campus of an NIH-funded Cancer Center, the Institute for Genomic Medicine, the Columbia Genome Center, and the Children's Hospital of New York provide additional opportunities for clinical interactions and research collaborations. Faculty rank will be commensurate with qualifications with the appointment on or before July 1, 2016.
