

### **Associate Director of Clinical Chemistry**

The Department of Pathology, Microbiology, and Immunology at Vanderbilt University Medical Center seeks an experienced board-certified clinical chemist. The Medical Center core laboratory is a state-of-the-art facility that analyzes over 4 million tests a year in support of patient care for the Vanderbilt University Hospital, Monroe Carell Jr. Children's Hospital at Vanderbilt, and the outreach program of the Vanderbilt Pathology Laboratory Services.

The successful applicant will have an M.D. and/or Ph.D. degree and should be board certified by the American Board of Clinical Chemistry or the American Board of Pathology (in Clinical Pathology) with a minimum of 5 years of professional experience within a high volume clinical laboratory in an academic center. Candidates must have significant experience in clinical consultation of test results as well as experience in method development and performance evaluation of specialized chemistry instrumentation, including general laboratory automation, immunoassay analyzers, HPLC, GC, or LC/MS-MS. Additional responsibilities will include teaching and mentoring pathology residents, medical technology students, medical students, and clinical chemistry fellows as well as conducting basic or clinical research. The candidate will work closely with the other chemistry faculty and management team in the administration, education, management, and research and development activities of the core laboratory.
