

Transfusion Medicine Faculty Position at Yale

The Department of Laboratory Medicine at the Yale School of Medicine is actively seeking MD or MD/PhD candidates for an Assistant Director position in the Transfusion Medicine Section at Yale-New Haven Hospital and Yale School of Medicine. The candidate must be board-certified or board-eligible in Blood Banking / Transfusion Medicine; certification in Clinical Pathology is also preferred. The position is on the full-time faculty, with rank appropriate to qualifications. Responsibilities will emphasize clinical and educational components but the successful candidate will also be expected to engage in scholarly investigation in a collaborative fashion. Individuals with an interest in a larger research component are also welcome to apply.

Yale New Haven is the fifth largest hospital in the United States and includes the YNHH Children's Hospital and Smilow Cancer Center. The Transfusion Service supports major programs in Stem Cell Transplantation and Therapeutic Apheresis, and includes a state-of-the-art Cell Therapy Laboratory. It is one of four national "hubs" for the NIH REDS III program and has a long-standing NIH Immunohematology post-doctoral research training program along with competitive TM clinical fellowships.
