The Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine at the University of Vermont College of Medicine, in affiliation with our university hospital, The University of Vermont Medical Center, seeks a pathologist with expertise in molecular genetic pathology to assist in the growth of our Molecular Pathology services. This is a full-time position with a faculty appointment on the Clinical Scholar Pathway (non-tenure) at the Assistant Professor rank. Strong diagnostic and laboratory management skills with prior experience signing out somatic and inherited disorder tests, including next generation sequencing tests, is essential. Additional desirable expertise includes bioinformatics, computational biology, and/or experience with clinical pharmacogenomics. The ideal candidate will have academic interests in medical student, resident and/or fellow education as well as scholarly activities such as clinical, translational and/or health services research. The applicant must have a M.D. or D.O., be board certified in Anatomic Pathology and/or Clinical Pathology, and be board eligible or certified in Molecular Genetic Pathology.

The Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine and the University of Vermont is especially interested in candidates who can contribute to the diversity and excellence of the academic community through their research, teaching, and/or service. Applicants are requested to include in their cover letter information about how they have worked toward diversity and inclusion in previous positions and will further this goal at the University of Vermont.
