Position Title: Assistant/Associate Director, Clinical Chemistry Laboratories

The University of Chicago's Department of Pathology, Clinical Chemistry Laboratories, seeks applications for the position of Assistant/Associate Director. The Clinical Chemistry section has state-of-the-art total laboratory automation and LC MS/MS systems providing a vast array of clinical diagnostic tests to our medical center, affiliated network and outreach clients. Candidates must have a PhD (American Board of Clinical Chemistry certified or eligible) or an MD (American Board of Pathology certified or eligible in Clinical Pathology) and hold or be able to obtain an Illinois medical license by start of employment. The candidate must have experience in general diagnostic clinical chemistry, immunoassays, endocrinology, therapeutic drug management, and toxicology. Working experience in mass spectrometry (drugs and proteomics applications), and molecular diagnostics (pharmacogenomics) experience is highly desirable. The successful candidate must have strong problem-solving, multi-tasking, and interpersonal skills. The candidate will be expected to assist the Director to oversee the quality management program, perform SPEP/IFE screening, evaluate and implement new tests, participate in teaching clinical chemistry fellows in our ComACC program, pathology residents and medical technologists, provide consults to clinicians, and perform clinical/translational research. Candidates must qualify for a faculty appointment; rank and salary will be commensurate with experience and accomplishments.
