

The Department of Laboratory Medicine at the Yale University School of Medicine is seeking applications for an informatics physician-scholar with clinical pathology expertise for a full-time ladder faculty position in the Department. The successful candidate would be expected to spend at least 50% time in investigative work in the field of “computational health informatics” and develop her/his own independent research program. The remaining effort would be in clinical and educational duties. Candidates should be MDs or MD/PhDs who are certified/board eligible in Clinical Pathology; certification/eligibility in one or more subspecialties of Laboratory Medicine is preferred.
