The successful candidate will engage in clinical proteomics and targeted quantitative development and validation studies on relevant proteins, drugs, hormones and other metabolites derived from blood, biological fluids and tissues. Other duties include maintaining LC MS/MS instruments and utilization of proteomic and bioinformatics databases/software for analyses and interpretation of protein/peptide data. Candidates must have a Ph.D. (or equivalent) in chemistry, analytical chemistry, biochemistry, or a related biomedical science. Prior experience in chromatography and mass spectrometry with a focus on proteomics and metabolomics is highly desirable, as is experience with bioinformatics software tools.
